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CODE OF CONDUCT

ALL STUDENTS AND PARENTS ARE TO READ & ACKNOWLEDGE THE FOLLOWING CODE OF CONDUCT

Appropriate attitude of all White Tiger Taekwondo and/or Haidong Gumdo members.

1. All students must wear an approved HG or TKD uniform at all training sessions.
 2. All students must bow to the senior instructor on entering or leaving the training hall.
 3. All students must bow to the senior instructor on entering or leaving a TKD or HG class or formal function.
 4. When sitting in class students must cross their legs and pay attention to the class instructor.
 5. When standing in class and listening to the class instructor students must have their hands behind their back.
 6. If the Master of the school enters or leaves the training Centre: The Instructor must greet him. Then the instructor or leadership team member must instruct class to formally bow to him. The class must remain standing to attention until the Master informs the instructor to carry on.
 7. If a student needs to adjust their uniform or belt during a formal class they must turn their back to the instructor or master
 8. When a student of the school is coming to, or finished at the training Centre: They must not have their belts on and they must have their uniform top covered.
 9. The uniform must be clean and tidy.
 10. Abusive or aggressive behaviour by any student or instructor during or outside the class environment will not be tolerated.
 11. No alcohol, tobacco or drug use is permitted at any HG or TKD function.
 12. Loud talking and playing games are not allowed at the training Centre, gradings or formal HG and TKD functions.
 13. Any complaints or comments regarding a student(s) or instructor(s) within the club are to be directed to the Senior Instructor or Master.
 14. The head instructor is to be advised of any injuries or medical complaints regarding any student or instructor.
 15. Any student with an injury where blood is present must immediately cease training and inform the instructor in charge. The injury must be attended to immediately.
 16. Any student or instructor who acts in a discriminatory manner will be expelled from the club.
 17. Any student or instructor who initiates sexual harassment towards another student or instructor will be expelled from the club.
 18. Learnt techniques are only to be practiced during class activities. Any student or instructor who is found to be using HG or TKD techniques outside of the class or formal function environment will be expelled from the club.
 19. All students must have their fellow students or instructors permission to physically touch another student or instructor during self-defence activities.
 20. All fellow students must act responsibly and with the utmost respect to their family, work, school and community members.
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Appropriate attitudes of Instructors and Leadership Team members.

1. The Instructor or Leadership Team member must have an approachable personality so that the students can respect them
2. The Instructor or Leadership Team member must be aware that some students may follow their example, behaviours and/ or opinions.
3. The Instructor or Leadership Team member must not slander or defame their companions or superiors in front of their students.
4. The Instructor or Leadership Team member must have a definite attitude.
5. The Instructor or Leadership Team member must correctly distinguish between public and private matters. They must act in a caring and responsible way to the students.
6. The Instructor or Leadership Team member must have a counselling rather than an ordering manner.

Special considerations towards the master of school

1. The Master of the club must not be questioned or debated on any issue publicly under no circumstances. The complaint or request must be formally put into writing and will be dealt with by the Master within 7 days or receipt.
2. The Instructors or Leadership Team members must uphold club etiquette on behalf of the Master.
3. The Instructor or Leadership Team member will line students up before class. If the Master or Senior Instructor is consulting another student and is unable to start class, an Instructor or Leadership team member must start the warm up and stretching program.

Club's courtesy rule

Every student in the club has a right to tell their training partners/instructors they wish to lighten up the intensity of the set exercise they are practicing. The club's courtesy rule also requires all students to ask for their training partner's permission to physically contact them.

PLEASE NOTE

Any abusive behaviour from parents or siblings toward any club member, club's family member or instructor of the club will result in the person involved being banned from attending any Taekwondo function.
ANY STUDENT OR INSTRUCTOR FOUND TO CLEARLY DISOBEY THE CODE OF CONDUCT WILL BE EXPELLED FROM THE CLUB.
